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FAQ

1. Do I need a driving license to ride an ATV in Nepal?

No, a driving license is not required for most ATV tours in Nepal, especially for beginner-friendly trails. However, riders must be above a certain age (usually 16 or older) and follow the safety instructions provided by the tour guide.

2. What should I wear for an ATV ride in Pokhara?

Comfortable clothes that you don't mind getting a bit dusty or muddy are best. Long pants and closed-toe shoes are recommended. Helmets and safety gear will be provided by the tour operator.

3. Is ATV riding in Nepal suitable for beginners?
