

Nagarkot Sunrise Day Tour - 1 Days

Nagarkot Sunrise Tour is a must-visit attraction in the beautiful Kathmandu Valley. It offers breathtaking views of the Great Himalayan ranges and the most glorious sunrise and sunset you can imagine. It's the perfect way to enjoy the majestic mountain views without having to go on a long hike. There are various itineraries available, including sunrise and sunset tours, hiking, and short treks, so you can choose the one that suits your interests the best.

The Nagarkot Sunrise tour is an incredible experience for those who are short on time but still want to explore the Himalayan ranges, including the famous Mt. Everest. You'll start your trip early in the morning and reach the viewpoint just in time for the sunrise. Located at an elevation of 2170m from sea level, Nagarkot is about 32 km away from the center of Kathmandu and is situated in the Bhaktapur District. From this eastern ridge, you'll be able to witness the stunning sunrise and sunset views over the great Himalayas. It's one of the closest viewpoints to Mt. Everest from Kathmandu.

Nepal is blessed with scenic landscapes, diverse flora and fauna, rich culture, traditions, and fine arts. These incredible features attract tourists from all over the world who want to experience the beauty of this country. A six-hour sightseeing tour to Nagarkot will not only give you a glimpse of its natural beauty but also allow you to immerse yourself in the cultural and artistic heritage of Nepal.

Nagarkot is famous for its enchanting sunrise and warm sunset, which can be enjoyed from the view tower located on the hilltop at an elevation of 2170m. Even from a distance, Nagarkot offers awe-inspiring panoramas of eight mountain ranges, including the Annapurna range, Manaslu range, Ganesh Himal range, Langtang range, Number range, Mahalangur range, Jugal range, and Rolwaling ranges. Out of the 15 Himalayan ranges in Nepal, you'll be able to see a significant portion of them from Nagarkot. Additionally, you'll also get a stunning view of the entire Kathmandu Valley and the Shivapuri National Park. During the tour, we'll make a stop at Hotel Himalayan Villa for breakfast, and then we'll embark on a short hike for a couple of hours to further explore the area.

Only for Nagarkot Sunrise Tour: 4 Hours :

The cost of the Nagarkot Sunrise Tour depends on the size of the group. For a group of 1 person, the cost is \$70. If there are 2 to 3 people, the cost is \$45 per person. For a group of 4 to 6 people, the cost is \$35 per person. And for a group of 7 to 12 people, the cost is \$25 per person.

The cost also varies based on the group size. If there is 1 person, the cost is \$125 per person. For a group of 2 to 3 people, the cost is \$85 per person. If there are 4 to 6 people, the cost is \$75 per person. And for a group of 7 to 12 people, the cost is \$65 per person.

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Day 1: Early Morning by car visit to Nagarkot to see the sunrise.

For this day we will start our journey early in the morning. A vehicle will be ready to pick you up and take you to Nagarkot. It will be a 1.5-2 hrs drive from Kathmandu until Nagarkot viewpoint. Nagarkot offers breathtaking panoramic views of the Himalayas, including several prominent peaks such as Mount Everest, Langtang, Ganesh Himal, and Dorje Lakpa. The scenic beauty and stunning sunrise and sunset views make Nagarkot a favorite destination for tourists and locals alike. From there we will then drive to Bhaktapur Durbar Square, which is located in the city of Bhaktapur. The well-preserved medieval buildings and traditional Newari culture make this UNESCO World Heritage site notable. Admire the royal complex, courtyards, and the famed Nyatapola Temple, which are all exquisitely carved wooden temples. You may also participate in numerous activities in pottery square and art galleries, as well as see residents performing traditional crafts. We will go from Bhaktapur to Changu Narayan Temple, which is located on a mountaintop near the settlement of Changu. This medieval Hindu temple dedicated to Lord Vishnu is well-known for its historical and artistic value. Enjoy the sweeping views of the surrounding countryside while marveling at the beautiful stone sculptures and statues. Finally, we will head back to our respective accommodations.
