ITINERARY IN DETAIL

Day 1: Kathmandu – Nepalgunj

Transfer from Kathmandu to Nepalgunj. Upon arrival, hotel check-in and rest.

Accommodation: [Hotel Soaltee Westend](#) or similar

Day 2: Nepalgunj – Simikot (Flight)

Early morning flight to Simikot (2,950 m). Rest and acclimatization day.

Accommodation: [Karnali Resort](#) or similar

Day 3: Simikot – Hilsa (Helicopter) – Purang

Helicopter flight to Hilsa (3,700 m). Cross the Karnali River and drive to Purang for acclimatization.

Accommodation: Purang Himalaya Hotel or similar

Day 4: Purang – Lake Manasarovar

Drive to sacred Lake Manasarovar (4,600 m). Complete lake parikrama.

Accommodation: Parmarth Ashram or similar

Day 5: Manasarovar – Darchen

Early morning puja at Lake Manasarovar. Drive to Darchen.

Accommodation: Kailash Himalaya Hotel or similar

Day 6: Darchen – Dirapuk (Trek Begins)

Drive to trek starting point. Trek to Dirapuk (15 km / 6–7 hrs).

Accommodation: Hotel Dirapuk

Day 7: Dirapuk – Zhuthulpuk

Longest trekking day of the Kailash Kora (18 km / 10–12 hrs).

Accommodation: Hotel Zhuthulpuk

Day 8: Zhuthulpuk – Darchen – Purang

Complete Kailash Parikrama. Drive back to Purang.

Accommodation: Purang Himalaya Hotel or similar

Day 9: Purang – Simikot – Nepalgunj – Kathmandu

FAQ

1. Is this Kailash Manasarovar Yatra suitable for beginners?

Yes. The helicopter-assisted route and acclimatization days make it suitable for first-time pilgrims with reasonable fitness.

2. Do I need prior trekking experience?

No technical trekking experience is required, but participants should be prepared for long walking days during the parikrama.

3. Is medical support available during the yatra?

A qualified high-altitude medical doctor is stationed at Lake Manasarovar, with oxygen and first aid available throughout.

4. What is the maximum altitude reached on this trip?

The highest point is Dirapuk at approximately 4,860 meters.

5. Are fixed departure dates available for 2026?

Yes. Multiple fixed group departures are scheduled from May to September 2026.
