It can act like a binocular for making a smart peek at the chaos city of Kathmandu. The Temple is a religious place for both Hindus and Buddhists. Located on the Top of the Hill, this holy shrine is an imposing stupa with Fascinating Buddha eyes and a golden spire. This place offers a breathtaking view of Kathmandu Valley. This site is believed to have originated 2000 years ago.
