ITINERARY IN DETAIL

Day 1: Drive from Pokhara hotel to Sarankot.

After spending the night in Pokhara, we will take a cab to Sarankot for paragliding, which will take around 30-40 minutes from Lakeside Pokhara. Upon arrival, you will be given a detailed briefing by professional instructors, ensuring that you have a solid grasp of safety precautions and flying protocols.

Tandem flights take off after you are strapped and ready, providing breathtaking views of the Annapurna mountain range, Phewa Lake, and the scenic Pokhara Valley. The flight time varies from 20-30 minutes to over an hour of flying over the Himalayan terrain. The landing, which is frequently near Phewa Lake, signals the conclusion of this adrenaline-pumping adventure. From there, we will then drop you off at your accommodation in Pokhara.



FAQ

1. Is paragliding in Pokhara safe for first-time flyers?

Yes, Pokhara is one of the safest places for tandem paragliding. All flights are operated by licensed pilots who follow international safety standards and provide detailed pre-flight briefings.

2. What is the best season for paragliding in Pokhara?

The best time for paragliding in Pokhara is during the dry seasons – autumn (September to November) and spring (March to May). These periods offer clear skies and stable wind conditions for smooth flights.

3. How long is the actual paragliding flight?

Most standard flights last between 20 to 30 minutes, depending on the weather conditions and the type of flight chosen. Cross-country flights may last longer.

4. What should I wear for paragliding?

Wear comfortable clothes suitable for light activity. Closed-toe shoes, sunglasses, and a light jacket or windbreaker are recommended, as it can get chilly in the air.

5. Do I need to book paragliding in advance?

While same-day bookings are sometimes possible, it's better to book at least a day in advance—especially during peak tourist season—to secure your preferred time slot.

6. Can I carry a camera or phone during the flight?

For safety reasons, it's best to let the pilot handle photo or video recording using a mounted GoPro. Many packages include professional photos and videos of your flight.

7. Are there any age or weight restrictions for paragliding?

Yes. Generally, the minimum age is 6 years, and the weight limit is between 20 kg to 100 kg. These limits ensure the safety and comfort of both pilot and passenger.

8. Is paragliding possible during the monsoon season?

Paragliding is usually not recommended during the monsoon (June to August) due to unpredictable weather, poor visibility, and strong winds.

9. Where do flights land in Pokhara?

Most tandem flights land near the shores of Phewa Lake, offering a scenic and soft landing area close to Lakeside, the tourist hub of Pokhara.

10. Is travel insurance required for paragliding in Nepal?

While not mandatory, it's highly advisable to have travel insurance that covers adventure activities, including paragliding, in case of unexpected situations.
